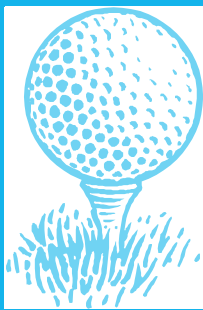

Colorado Crossroads National Qualifier

Triangle teams had two weekends of beautiful weather and beautiful play in Denver, CO earlier this month.
