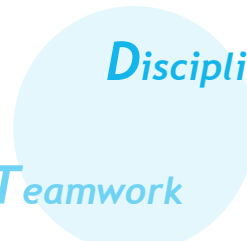

TRIANGLE at Jr. Olympic & AAU Nationals

Triangle ended the 2007 club season with best-ever club performances at AAU and Jr. Olympic Nationals.

Eight Triangle teams attended AAU Nationals in Orlando. Six Triangle teams finished in the top 25 in their respective age groups, including Triangle's fourth top-ten AAUs finish in four years. 14 Black finished T-11/27 in the 14 Open division, 16 Black finish T-9/75 in the 16 Club division, 17 Black finished T-13/63 in the 17 Club division, and 18 Black finished T-16/34 in the 18 Open division.

Triangle qualified and sent a record five teams to the USA Junior Olympics in Minneapolis. This is only the second time in region history that a North Carolina club has qualified this many teams to compete for the Junior Olympic National Championship (Carolina Juniors, Charlotte, NC - 2005).

The USA Jr. Olympics is the toughest competition in the country, with teams competing in three different divisions: Open, National and American. Every Triangle team competed hard, earning the Club's best overall finish in its five year history with the following results:

14 Black-National Division, tied for 13th place

15 Black-National Division, 38th place

16 Black-American Division, tied for 27th place

17 Black-American Division, tied for 47th place

18 Black-National Division, tied for 5th place

In addition, Katie Kabbes (6' 5" Jr., Outside Hitter, Triangle 18 Black), became Triangle's second student-athletes to receive JOVC all-tournament honors (Megan Hodge '06 received honors in 2005).
