Kathleen (Katie) Slay, 6'6" MB, Triangle 18 Black (Sophomore, Wakefield High School), is one of 19 young women in the United States selected to train and compete for one of 12 spots on the *2008 U. S. Women's Junior National Team*. Katie will train from July 8-19 at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, California. Three teams will be formed from this group which will play in an international tournament in Tucson from July 23-27.
