## GUINNESS WORLD RECORD ATTEMPT FOR VOLLEYBALL AT RALEIGH CONVENTION CENTER

**RALEIGH, NC, FEBRUARY 5, 2010:** The Raleigh Convention Center [RCC] will be the site of a Guinness World Book Record attempt for the most consecutive volleyball passes. The attempt is in conjunction with the Mid-Atlantic Power League tournament [MAPL Raleigh] hosted by Triangle Volleyball Club at the RCC on February 6-7.

The current record is 92 consecutive passes over the net with a different individual making each pass. The attempt will be held **Friday, Feb. 5th at 7:30 PM** in RCC exhibit halls A-C [registration begins at 7:00 PM] and will involve Triangle Volleyball Club student-athletes, staff, and other MAPL Raleigh participants.

Triangle Volleyball Club will donate \$1 for every registered participant in the attempt to the [CLINTON BUSH HAITI FUND](#) to aid the victims of the recent earthquake in Haiti.

The current Guinness world record was established November 25, 2006 by SV Bayer Wuppertal (Germany), in the Bayerhall, Wuppertal, Germany. Guinness World Records is the universally recognized authority on record-breaking achievement. First published in 1955, the annual Guinness World Records book is published in more than 100 countries and 25 languages and is one of the highest-selling books under copyright of all time with more than 3 million copies sold annually across the globe.

MAPL Raleigh is the only convention center-based tournament in North Carolina involving North Carolina teams. With 20 high-performance courts under one roof, MAPL Raleigh will feature some of the best club volleyball teams from all along the eastern seaboard. MAPL Raleigh is open to the public. A one-day event pass is \$3 and a two-day pass is \$5.
